# A. Why do we need a BOLD course on prayer?

- 1. We believe that prayer is essential for everything we do as a church
  - We long to see a manifest power of the risen Christ in His church, and prayer is the means that God has given us to that end
- **2.** As disciples of Christ, we need to grow in all aspects of the Christian life, and prayer is foundational to our growth (Luke 11:1; Rom 8:26-27)

# B. Our objectives for the course

- **1.** To grow in our intimacy with God through prayer
- 2. To learn to pray in a manner prescribed for us in scripture (James 4:3; 1 John 5:14)
- 3. To grow in our commitment to prayer, both individually and corporately
  - God has woven our prayers into his eternal plans and purposes
  - Prayer is a direct assault on Satan's kingdom (Eph 6:18)

"Satan cannot deny but that great wonders have been wrought by prayer. As the spirit of prayer goes up, so his kingdom goes down" (W. Gurnall).

**4.** To be encouraged in our faith, as we see God hearing and answering our prayers

# C. Examples of prayer in scripture to emulate

- **1.** The Lord's prayer defines for us what prayer is:
  - a) Prayer is communion & fellowship with God our Father, and growing in intimacy with Him (Matt 6:9)
  - b) Prayer is worship (Matt 6:9-10)
  - c) Prayer is an acknowledgement of our dependence upon our Heavenly Father (Matt 6:11-13)
- 2. Lessons from Psalm 63 on the heart of prayer
  - a) Prayer emanates from a heart that longs to experience God's nearness & power (:1-2)
  - b) Prayer involves meditation on God's character until our hearts begin to worship (:3-5)
  - c) Prayer is a reflection on God's goodness till our hearts are filled with gratitude (:7-8)
